With reference to above, I am directed to inform that the compliance the Council Inspector's report (December, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Alluri Sitarama Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru carried out for purpose of recognition of DDVL qualification was considered by the Board of Governors and it was decided as under:-

"The Board of Governors considered the Council Inspector's report (December, 2009) and decided that DDVL qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada in respect of students being trained at Alluri Sitarama Raju Academy of Medical Sciences, Eluru be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 01(one) student per year."

The Board of Governors further decided that the attention of the Institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.
